

Diphenhydramine (Benadryl) Dosing Instructions

Every 6 hours as needed for allergy symptoms, allergic reactions and itching

The appropriate dose for your child is based on his/her weight. Locate your child's weight in the weight column. Next, find which product (form and strength/concentration) of diphenhydramine you have in the ones listed in the top row. Then, find your child's dose in that column. mg = milligrams, ml = milliters
